

This course is designed for Head of Department or Second in Department in D&T and those aspiring to such a role. The main emphasis is on management issues, risk assessment and monitoring of H&S. Technicians may also find this course useful.

The course involves a mixture of presenter input, discussion and exercises. The focus will be on reducing the chances of accidents involving staff and students to a minimum;

During the course the following items will normally be covered:-

- The law and health and safety. What the law requires employers, teachers, technician and heads of department to do.
- Exploration of basic principles relating to health and safety.
- Health and safety regulations and how they affect design and technology.
- Requirements for D&T rooms and workshop machines in respect of health and safety.
- Organising and managing risk assessment in design and technology, including the modification of model risk assessments.
- Use and maintenance of local exhaust ventilation
- Aspects of using and guarding machines in common use.

There will also be ample opportunities for participants to raise questions about their own concerns.

Participants who attend the whole course will receive a CLEAPSS Certificate of Attendance.
