

Health and Safety Management in Art and Design

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This course is designed for Heads of Department, Safety Officers and others who may have to oversee the Art & Design facilities in schools and other establishments. The main emphasis is on management issues, risk assessment and the monitoring of Health and Safety practice.

The course involves a mixture of presenter input, discussion and tasks. The focus will be on reducing the chances of accidents involving staff and students in the facility;

During the course the following items will normally be covered:-

- The law and health and safety. What the law requires employers, teachers, technicians and heads of department to do.
- Exploration of basic principles relating to health and safety.
- Health and safety regulations and how they affect Art and Design.
- Requirements for Art and Design rooms, dark rooms and workshops in respect of health and safety.
- Organising and managing risk assessments, including the customisation of model risk assessments.
- Use and maintenance of local exhaust ventilation
- Aspects of using and guarding for machines & equipment in common use.

There will also be ample opportunities for participants to raise questions about their own concerns.

Participants who attend the whole course will receive a CLEAPSS Certificate of Attendance.
