This one-day course is designed for technicians who work in D&T facilities in schools. It explores roles and responsibilities, risk assessment and the safe setup and use of equipment. To book a place contact CLEAPSS.

Note: this course is running as part of the <u>Sci Tech conference</u> at The University of Birmingham School in Selly Oak on June 30th. Participants attending this course will also have access to the conference including breakfast and lunch.

The course involves a mixture of presenter input, discussion, and tasks.

The focus will be on reducing the chances of accidents involving staff and students to a minimum.

During the course the following items will be covered: -

- The law and health and safety. What the law requires of employers, teachers, and technicians.
- Exploration of basic principles relating to health and safety.
- Health and safety regulations and how they affect Design and Technology.
- Requirements for D&T rooms and workshop machines in respect of health and safety.
- Organising and managing risk assessment in Design and Technology, including the customisation of model risk assessments.
- Use and maintenance of local exhaust ventilation.
- Aspects of using and guarding for machines in common use.

There will also be ample opportunities for participants to raise questions about their own concerns.
