This is a one-day introduction to health and safety for school Science technicians.



Course objectives:

- raise awareness of safety issues and current H&S legislation
- to increase your confidence about your responsibilities
- to help you become more aware of the full range of CLEAPSS services and advice
- to consider and practise risk assessments for technician activities
- to explore what “managing safely” means in practice for technicians

During the course, the following will be covered:

- sharing common H&S concerns & identifying possible solutions
- health and safety legislation including the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 and its subsequent regulations
- legal bans, myths and rumours
- risk assessment in general, and personal risk assessment for technician activities
- searching the CLEAPSS website to find health & safety information relevant to technician activities
