This three-hour (maximum) online course is an extension to the self-study Health & Safety for science technicians course available via http://science.cleapss.org.uk/.

This live online session will give participants the opportunity to raise any questions arising from the self-study course and to explore health and safety issues relevant to technicians and their jobs in more detail. There will be opportunities for participants to share good practice, raise their own concerns and work with the tutors to identify possible solutions.

To aid discussion participant numbers are limited to a maximum of 20 per session.

Topics covered will include:

Personal protective equipment. Security of labs and prep rooms.

Carrying out mandatory checks. Security of chemicals and equipment.

Technicians' personal risk assessment. Observing unsafe practice – how to respond.

Lone working. Introducing safer systems and procedures.

The live session will be delivered via Zoom.

You **MUST** have access to the following in order to participate: PC/Laptop/tablet with a **camera and a microphone**, the latest version of Zoom installed with access to a reliable broadband connection. (note; a mobile phone will not be suitable)
