

# Assessing & managing risk in Art and Design

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This course is designed for teachers and technicians working the Art & Design area. The course takes place in a school Art and Design department and involves a mixture of presenter input and practical exercises.

The course begins with an investigation of the guidance, regulation, legislation and roles and responsibilities in the area of Art and Design in terms of Health and Safety.

We will investigate the role of COSHH and how best to manage hazardous chemicals in the department.

We will carry out practical risk assessment activities and discuss how best to record the outcome of the risk assessment process.

There will be an opportunity to investigate how to audit health and safety in an Art and Design department.

The course also covers the safe establishment of a ceramics area, including management of the kiln and associated equipment, however, this course is will **not** cover kiln use.

We also cover the safe management of a photographic dark room and the associated equipment and chemicals.

The course ends with a 'next steps' session, where participants can investigate where to go next for further training and how to use the CLEAPSS helpline for support.

Participants who attend the course will receive a CLEAPSS certificate of attendance.
